



Perfect party pink?

The nose bursts with exotic aromas of lychee and honeysuckle and the palate is alive with red berry fruit flavours, but unless you want to go bare foot, this wine promises not to knock your socks off. Have Wirra Wirra just produced the perfect party pink?

It has all the elements of fun in a glass – it's a little bit fizzy, a little bit sweet, and a little bit smaller at only 500mL per bottle. And it's more than a little bit lighter than your average bottle coming in at just 4.5% alc/vol.

The **2009 Wirra Wirra Mrs Wigley Moscato** is the first wine made and the first wine released for the team at Wirra Wirra each year – and this year's is a beauty.

Fresh exotic fruit flavours and a wonderful richness are balanced by a refreshing sherbet acidity and the tingle of fine spritz. It is best served chilled accompanying Ricotta Pancakes with honeycomb butter and fresh strawberries, or as the celebratory gesture that concludes a long lunch with good friends.

Winemaker Samantha Connew suggests that it is just the trick for Spring and Summer sipping;

"We deliberately made this wine with a very low alcohol content and in a 500ml bottle to give drinkers a wine that they can enjoy during the day – and at 4.5%, it is a third the alcohol of your average glass of wine!"

So just who is Mrs Wigley? This wine was named after a legendary pussycat that loved nothing more than to laze in the sun outside the Wirra Wirra winery. Born at a neighbouring residence, she became part of the Wirra Wirra tribe after her mum dragged her litter to settle in Wirra Wirra's open fermenters.
