From the 2007 vintage, the Adelaide Hills Sauvignon Blanc joins Woodhenge Shiraz, Catapult Shiraz Viognier and The 12th Man Chardonnay in the RGT Collection, our tribute to the late Greg Trott. It will be known as The Hiding Champion in memory of Trott's habit of "going missing" whenever the more mundane matters of the everyday required consideration. Like all the wines in this collection, the story behind the name is shared on the label.

Grape Variety:	100% Sauvignon Blanc
Region:	100% Lenswood Adelaide Hills
Colour:	Light straw with specks of green.
Bouquet:	A vibrant nose with fresh gooseberries, papaya and dried bananas with hints of green apples, fresh peas and mineral aromas.
Palate:	A well balanced lively palate expressing layers of fruit, particularly melon and passionfruit flavours that contribute to a long, intense and lingering finish that is clean and crisp.
Cellaring Potential:	Best consumed whilst young & vibrant.

Serve:	Hot smoked salmon with asparagus and baby herbs.
