



2007 The Lost Watch Riesling

From the 2007 vintage, the Hand Picked Adelaide Hills Riesling joins Woodhenge Shiraz and Catapult Shiraz Viognier, The 12th Man Chardonnay and the Hiding Champion Sauvignon Blanc in the RGT Collection, our tribute to the late Greg Trott. It will be known as The Lost Watch Riesling in memory of Trott's decision to discard the idea of a timepiece early in life having lost the watch gifted to him by his father. From that day forward he was notoriously late for appointments—sometimes by minutes, hours and occasionally days. Like the wines in this collection, the story behind the name is shared on the label.

Grape Variety:	100% Riesling
Region:	100% Adelaide Hills, South Australia
Oak Maturation:	NA
Colour:	Pale Green Straw
Bouquet:	Lifted aromatics of grapefruit pith and nashi pears with some jasmine floral notes. Asian spice elements are also present with an almost freshly grated ginger background.
Palate:	The palate is lean and fine with a crunchy minerality and Granny Smith apple texture, finishing with lemon zest acidity.
General:	A full flavoured Australian style, made from hand picked grapes to minimise skin contact with the free-run juice, providing the wine with intense varietal aromas and flavours with a crisp and zesty finish. The wine is very attractive to drink now but will develop outstanding, toasty, bottled aged characters after two or three years.
Cellaring Potential:	Enjoy in its youth or cellar carefully for up to 7 years to be delightfully rewarded.

Serve:	Flounder fillets with Lemon and Herbs in Filo.
